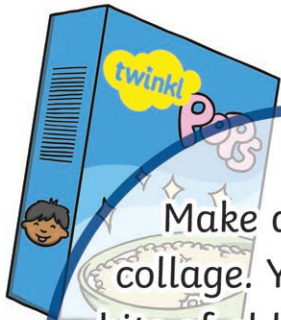


Colour
