



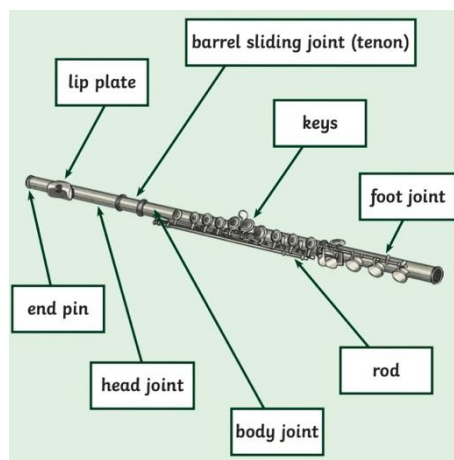

Spring Term – Flute

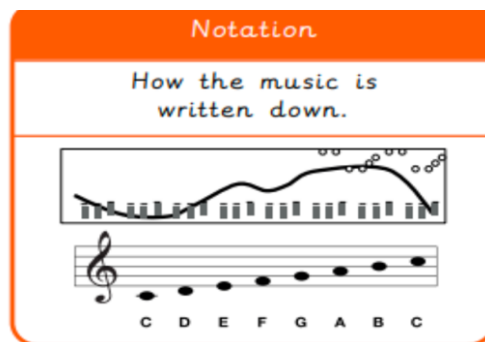

Key Knowledge and Skills:

In Year 4, Dudley Performing Arts tutor our pupils for half of a year.



The flute is a musical instrument in the woodwind family, though typically made of metal. It produces sound by blowing air across an edge, creating a vibrating column of air.



Notation is important to follow, when playing an instrument. Depending on which keys are pressed, different notes will be played- higher or lower in pitch.

Key Vocabulary:

Vocabulary:	Definition:
Pulse	The heartbeat of the music.
Rhythm	Long and short sounds/patterns.
Forte	High and low notes.
Tempo	The speed of the music.
Dynamics	How loud or quiet the music is.
Break	A four or eight beat rhythm, which is usually played once or twice.
Musical Stave	A staff is five horizontal lines that indicate the pitch of musical notes with the help of a clef
