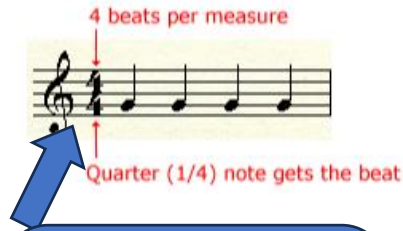

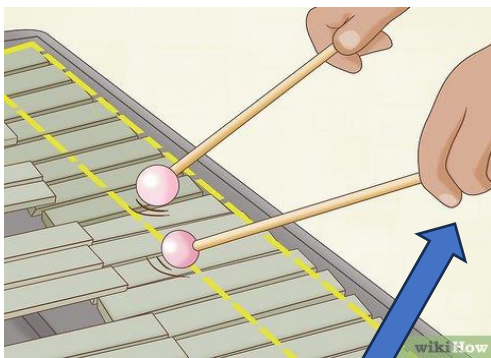
Different notes are held for a different number of beats.

Sign	Name	Relative Length	In 4/4 Time
	Semibreve	Whole note	4 beats
	Minim	Half note	2 beats
	Crotchet	Quarter note	1 beat
	Quaver	Eighth note	1/2 beat
	Semiquaver	Sixteenth note	1/4 beat



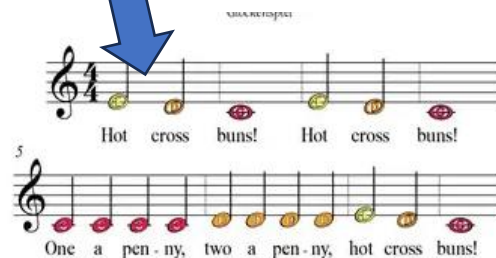
The numbers next to the treble clef shows how many beats are in a measure/bar. So, 4 means there are 4 beats in a bar.

How to hold the beater.





Hold the beaters lightly at the ends. Don't hold it too tightly.

The staff is the name of the ladder. When the notes are higher on the ladder, they are higher in pitch.
