



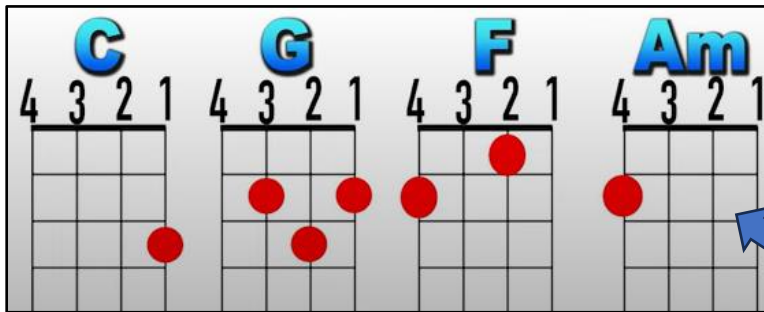

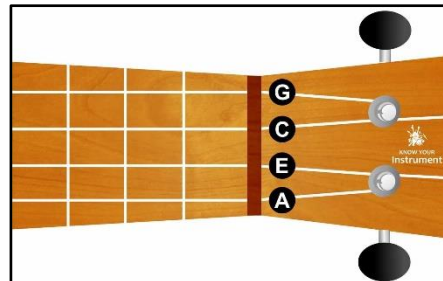
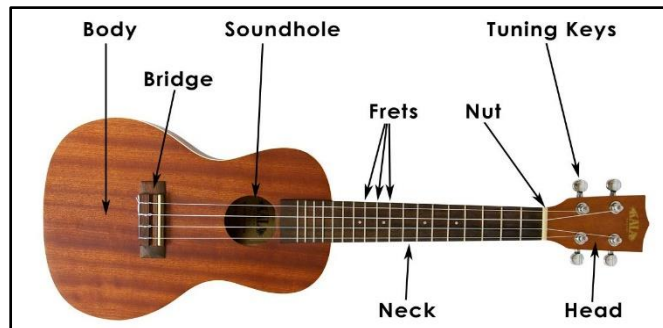
Key Knowledge and Skills:

Ukulele is a member of the string family. Each string, when pressed correctly, will play a different note. You will learn C, G, F, Am chords this year.



The red dots show which finger should be pressed on which string. The combination of notes create the chord.

All strings are strummed to create the sound of the chord. Strings are plucked to play individual notes.

Musical Stave	A stave is five horizontal lines that indicate the pitch of musical notes with the help of a clef
Chord/Strum	Relating to the playing of the ukulele, you will learn a variety of chords and strum to make different sounds.
