The Night of Power	The night of the first revelation to Muhammad
Ramadan	A special time in the Muslim calendar
Qur'an	Islamic holy scripture
Mosque	Muslim place of worship
Dome	Shape of roof to amplify prayers to heaven
Minaret	Special tower where prayer callings are held
Wudu	Washing ritual in preparation for prayer
