Key Knowledge

What should we know by the end of this topic?

- The book of Genesis tells the story of creation
- Many Christians believe the world and everything in it was created in six days, and the seventh day was given for rest
- Many Christians believe that humankind was created perfectly by God, without sin
- Many Christians believe that Adam ate a forbidden fruit which meant God's people needed to be saved from sin
- God gave Moses Ten Commandments as guidance for what he expected of his people
- The people of Israel finally entered the 'Promised Land'
- 12 tribes of Israel were united under the leadership of Kings Saul, David and Solomon

These tribes were later divided.



- The Prophets deteriorated
- The people were exiled to Babylonia

Boaz showed kindness towards Ruth:

- He protected her
- He fed her well and gave her water
- He provided her with food to take home

Passover

- Passover is celebrated to remember the liberation (freedom) of the Israelite slaves in Ancient Egypt.

Vocabulary	Definition
Creation	When the world and everything in it was made
The Fall	The name given to describe humankind's fall after Adam ate the forbidden fruit
Abraham	The founder of Judaism
Moses	A prophet of God who received the 10 Commandments
Passover	A Jewish festival which commemorates the freeing of Israelite slaves in Egypt
10 Commandments	Guidance given to Moses to describe what God expected of his people
The Promised Land	The land of Canaan which was promised to Abraham and his people
Assyrians	Inhabitants of Ancient Assyria
Babylonians	Inhabitants of Babylonia
Persians	Inhabitants of Persia
The Messiah	Promised deliverer of the Jewish people
