What should we know by the end of this topic?

- Jesus arrived in Jerusalem riding a donkey to celebrate Passover and fulfil prophecy
- Key events in the life of Jesus, including key miracles and parables, the selection of his disciples, the story of his transfiguration (revealing his divine glory)

The Sermon on the Mount

An address delivered by Jesus which shared the importance of living a life of love, compassion and selflessness.

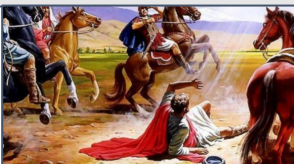


- The storyline of the last weeks of Jesus' life including Palm Sunday, temple cleansing, The Last Supper, the crucifixion, resurrection and ascension
- The Church first began on the day of Pentecost shortly after Jesus' death
- The Church was founded based on the teachings of Jesus

Saul → Apostle Paul

Saul was persecuting Christians.
Jesus appeared to him.
He suddenly converted.

He became known as Paul (the Apostle).
He began to teach Christianity, spreading the gospel and establishing churches.

Jesus	Founder of Christianity
Baptism	Ritual of admission into the Christian faith
Sermon	The talk with a religious or moral subject
Miracles	An extraordinary event
Parables	A story used to teach a moral
Transfiguration	The revelation of Jesus' divine glory
Palm Sunday	The Sunday before Easter, when Jesus' entry into Jerusalem is celebrated
Last Supper	Final meal before Easter, when Jesus was betrayed
Disciples	Followers of Jesus during his life
Apostles	The 12 chief disciples of Jesus
Crucifixion	When Jesus was killed on the cross
Resurrection	When Jesus rose from the dead
Conversion	Changing from one religious perspective to another
Missionary	A person sent on a mission to promote a religion
