Vocabulary	Definition
<b>Location</b>	A particular place or position.
<b>Region</b>	An area of land.
<b>Physical Features</b>	Features that are not made by humans, such as mountains, lakes and rivers.
<b>Human Features</b>	Features that have been built or developed by humans, such as settlements and farming.
<b>Earthquakes</b>	A sudden violent shaking of the ground, as a result of movements within the Earth's crust or volcanic action.
<b>Volcanoes</b>	An opening in the Earth's surface allowing gas, hot magma and ash to escape from beneath the Earth's crust.
<b>Land use</b>	What land is used for, such as farming or housing.
<b>Economic activity</b>	When goods or services are sold in return for money.
<b>Tourism</b>	How a location is used for holidays and visits to places of interest.
<b>Climate</b>	The weather conditions within an area over a long period of time.
