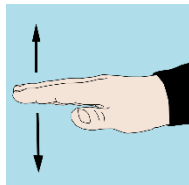


**Key Knowledge and Skills:**

Develop cooperation and teamwork skills: Communicate in a group and listen to others' ideas. Share ideas within a team and decide on the best approach to completing a task. Be respectful of each other's input. Different types of communication are key – e.g. speaking, listening, eye contact, hand gestures.

Develop trust: When using voice commands with a partner, be clear and descriptive with your instructions so that they know exactly what to do. Signals may be useful to help teammates. Think about different ways you could support your teammates to make them feel more comfortable and be more successful.
