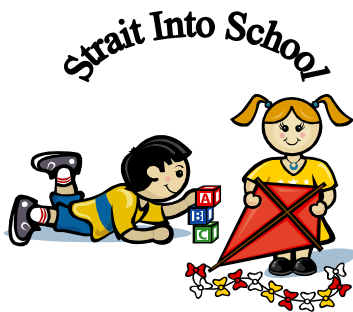

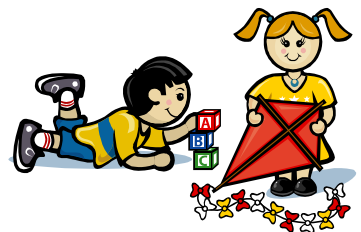

'Straits-after-school' Club

Here is some information about the 'Straits-after-school' club that you may find useful. If you need any more information please do not hesitate to ask.

Club Routine

3.25-4.00pm - Welcome. Snack and drink. Reading or any homework?

3.45-4.30pm - Structured activities. Games in play room or outdoors.

4.30-5.00pm - Snack time

5.00-6.00pm - Free choice of activities.

Food and Drinks

Snack before 4.30pm - choice of biscuits, or fresh fruit.

Drinks are available - No added sugar squash and milk.

Snack after 4.30pm - A more substantial snack is offered to children who stay on for the second session. The children can choose from sandwiches, toasted snacks, chips/waffles (once a week on alternative days) etc. However this is not intended as a substitute for a main evening meal, it's just a snack until teatime.

Activities

There is a selection of puzzles, games and art and craft materials available to your child. The club has a selection of toys and play equipment suitable for all ages. When the weather permits the children will be encouraged to play outdoors for part of the session.

A structured activity is planned for each week; details of this will be given to your child at the beginning of each half-term.

Collecting your child

There is a bell to ring at the door so that you can let staff know that you are at the door when you collect your child. If your child is being collected by other person, please make sure that the staff knows this in advance. In an emergency or 'last minute' situation please try to telephone if possible.

Always make sure that the staff knows that you are taking your child.

Please feel free to talk to any member of staff if you have any concerns about your child or if there is anything you feel we should know. There is anything we need to let you know about we will either speak to you in person or send a letter home, whichever is appropriate. A notice board showing general information is displayed in our dining area.
