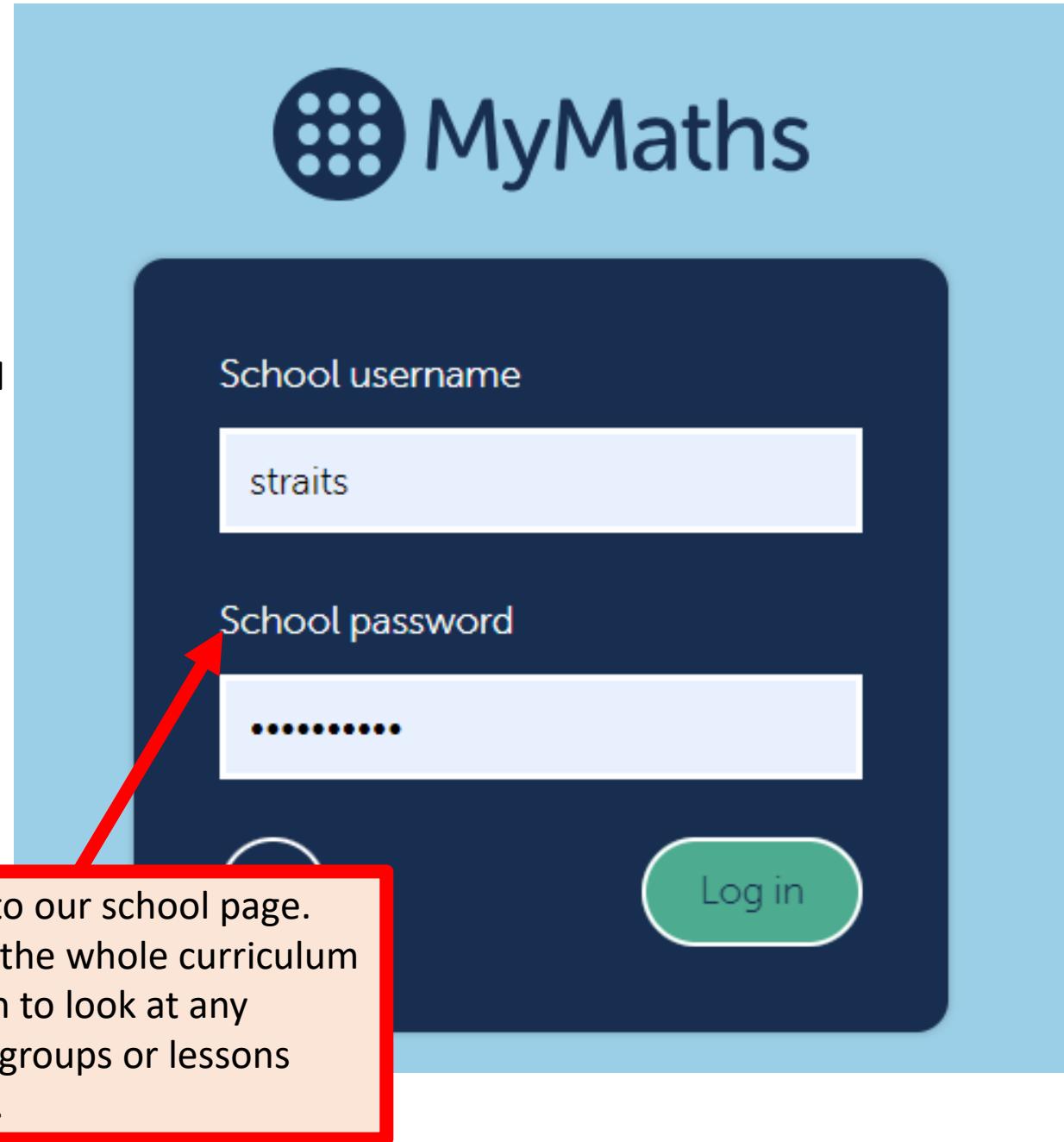

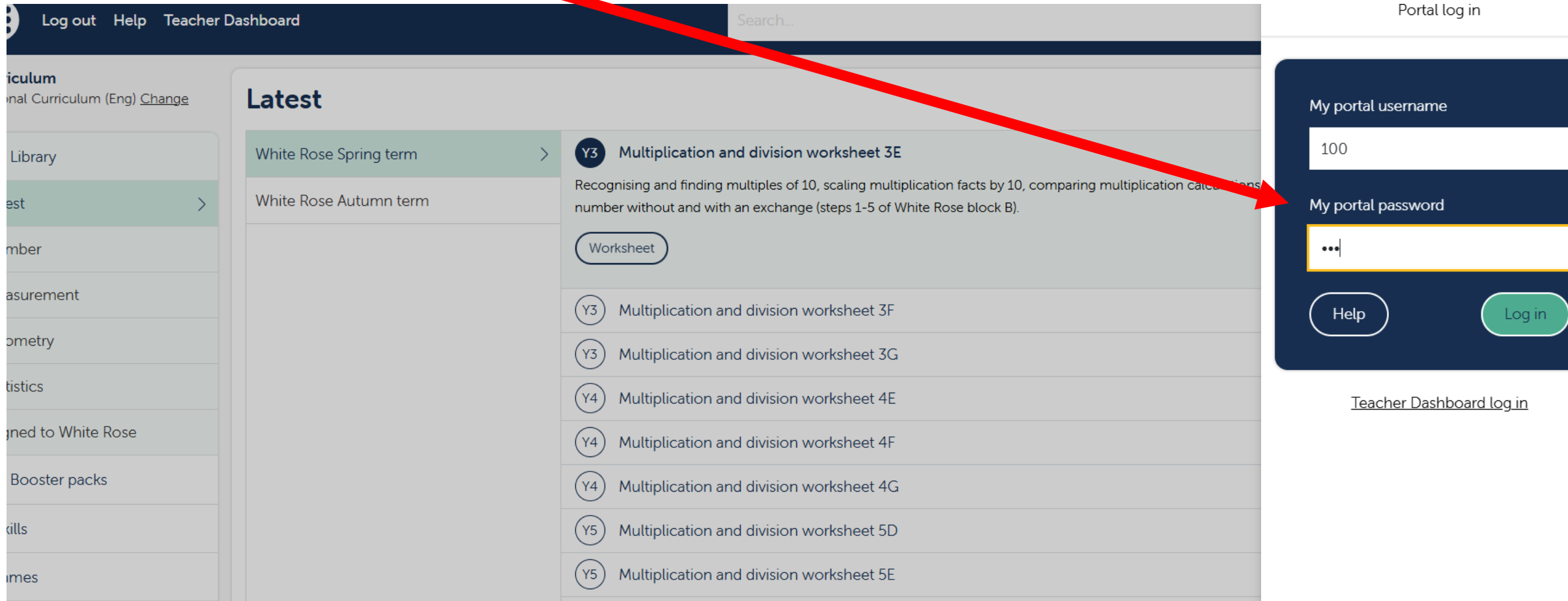

Homework: allocated tasks, lessons or activities

Task: *A piece of homework has been set (usually about 15 - 20 minutes of work)*

Lesson: *Can be matched to the task, it offers more explanation, teaching support, practise and videos. Use this if your child isn't confident or you want to look through the process/methods of the task (usually about 20-30 minutes)*

Activity: *This is more like a message service to pupils. It may be used to attach additional website links or reminders etc. This will be less frequently used in general.*

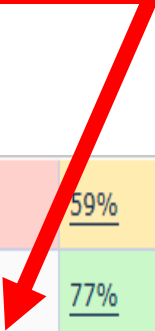
The practise TAB has the whole curriculum for you to try or explore. You could try to practise a weaker area, or push children further in an area of strength.
